Catalog Description

This course introduces students to airplane ground and flight operations, take-off and landing, basic flight maneuvers, cross-country methods, night flying, and emergency procedures. Includes flight instruction in single-engine aircraft and simulators. Prepares students for the required FAA Private Pilot Airplane Practical Test. Credit may be granted for presenting a valid FAA Private Pilot Certificate. Students must possess an FAA Class 3 or above Medical Certificate and be at least 17 years old. The course should be taken concurrently with AVIP 1013. Some students may require additional hours of flight instruction beyond the course minimum to pass the course.

Repeatable: Course not repeatable

Intended Learning Outcomes

Students who successfully complete this course will:

- 1. Pass the FAA Private Pilot Certificate Practical Exam.
- 2. Log at least 30 hours of dual flight instruction, 5 hours of simulator instruction, 10 hours of solo flight, 2 hours for the flight examination.
- 3. Demonstrate safe ground, flight operations and maneuvers appropriate for a Private Pilot.
- 4. Demonstrate take-offs and landings in a variety of environments and at night appropriate for a Private Pilot.
- 5. Demonstrate cross-country methods, navigation, use of airspace and communication appropriate for a Private Pilot.
- 6. Demonstrate emergency procedures and compliance with FAA regulations appropriate for a Private Pilot.
- 7. Demonstrate scheduling awareness regarding aircraft flight time and training.
